ith an experience spanning over 35 years, Mr. Sunil Kumar Bains currently holds the position of Director (Commercial) at Central UP Gas Limited. A graduate of civil engineering from the Delhi College of Engineering, Bains further pursued an MBA with a focus on marketing and human resources from FMS, Delhi. Additionally, he holds a master's in law with a specialisation in labour law from the Indian Law Institute, reflecting his multidisciplinary approach to education.

Under his astute guidance, CUGL has achieved notable milestones within a mere 13 months showcasing Bains' strategic acumen and positioning CUGL as a noteworthy player in the competitive CGD landscape. The company witnessed a commendable 45% growth in its customer base, a substantial 35% expansion in infrastructure, a remarkable 71% surge in revenues, and an impressive 51% uptick in profits. CUGL is also aligned with the Prime Minister's "Panchamrit" concept and is dedicated to reducing its carbon footprint and adopting clean energy solutions. The company's commitment to environmental sustainability is vividly showcased through its cutting-edge waste-to-energy facility. Capable of generating 40,000 kgs of bio-CNG, 20,000 kgs of CO2, and producing 300 metric tonnes of bio-compost daily by treating over 1,200 metric tonnes of Kanpur municipal waste, CUGL exemplifies a proactive stance toward carbon neutrality. This commitment is further reinforced by a 50kW grid-connected solar rooftop installation.

A strong advocate for work-life balance and employee engagement, Bains actively organises training programs for his team and strives to foster a culture of continuous learning and development. When not at work, he is an adventurer with diverse interests. From long-distance drives and photography to heritage walks, he brings a zest for exploration to his personal life.
